ABOUT

Centre County PAWS is pleased to offer the **Surviving Pet Care Program** to our community. If you are no longer able to care for your pet(s) or if they should outlive you, PAWS will take your pet(s) and help find them a new, loving home. Enrolling in the program will ensure peace of mind for you and your beloved companion animal(s).

ENROLLMENT

The fee for enrollment of your pet(s) in the Surviving Pet Care Program is as follows:

Option 1: If paid in full in cash or

other current payment at the time of enrollment, the enrollment fee is a reduced rate of \$7,500 for the first pet and \$5,000 for each additional pet. This payment option will entitle your enrolled pet(s) to be taken in by PAWS upon your death or in the event you become incapacitated or otherwise become unable to care for them during your lifetime.

Option 2: If paid on a deferred basis through a planned gift, the enrollment fee is \$10,000 for the first pet and \$7,500 for each additional pet. This payment option will entitle your enrolled pet(s) to be taken in by PAWS upon your death.

As in all matters pertaining to estate planning, we encourage you to contact your attorney to discuss enrollment in the Surviving Pet Care Program.
